Project Scope:

Commercial development near the intersection of CTH T and STH 29 in Chippewa County, Wisconsin had increased the amount of traffic at the intersection of CTH T and 33rd Ave. The Town of Wheaton ordered a Traffic Impact Analysis (TIA) of the intersection, which determined that traffic lights and turn lane expansions were needed to improve access to the new businesses in the area. Fleming, Andre and Assoc., Inc. were hired by the Town of Wheaton to provide design and construction engineering services for this TRIPD funded project.

New left and right turn lanes were added to the town road and the existing left turn lanes on CTH T were lengthened to increase capacity. SEH, Inc. provided traffic signal design expertise. Plans and specifications conforming to Wisconsin DOT standards were provided. Coordination with the existing utilities, Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, and the Chippewa County Highway Department was required during the duration of the project. Fleming, Andre and Assoc., Inc. also administered the bid letting.

Construction of the project was completed in early November of 2006. The funding timeline dictated that design and construction of the project be completed in under three months from the start of the project.
